Stormhold postcode survey

A survey of preferred SCA groups is being conducted for all SCA participants (members and non-members) in the border areas surrounding Stormhold. The survey is being conducted by the Lochac Seneschal. The aim of the survey is to determine whether the populace are happy with the current boundaries of the groups, and to settle a few items of confusion relating to boundaries between several of the groups. The survey is non-binding, and the final determination of group boundaries will be made by the Lochac Seneschal after consideration of the current borders, the wishes of the populace, and the shape of the boundaries (it is preferred that borders follow straight lines wherever possible).

Points to note

- It is proposed that a new canton be established, known as Newbridge, to cover most of the inner areas of Stormhold, including much of the area not already covered by Krae Glas, Dubh Thrain, or Arrowsreach.
- It is proposed that a poll be held to petition for the canton of Krae Glas to become a shire.

Both of these proposals will be subject to further polls after this survey is concluded.

Eligibility

The survey is open to all people in the Stormhold region, however the postcodes that are of most interest are as follows:

3012, 3019, 3032, 3039, 3031, 3055, 3056, 3057, 3070, 3052, 3054, 3068, 3078, 3071, 3072, 3081 Border area between Dubh Thrain and Newbridge.

Border area between Dubh Thrain, Newbridge, and Arrowsreach.

3103, 3123, 3126, 3124, 3122

Border area between Newbridge and Arrowsreach.

3125, 3128, 3151, 3149, 3148, 3147

Border area between Newbridge, Arrowsreach, and Krae Glas.

3152, 3155, 3133, 3155, 3154, 3786

Border area between Arrowsreach and Krae Glas.

3166, 3167, 3202, 3189, 3188, 3186, 3187, 3204, 3165, 3163, 3162, 3185, 3184

Border area between Newbridge and Krae Glas.

These areas comprise the border regions between the various shires and cantons, and include a number of postcodes one or two suburbs either side of the border regions to give a fairer indication of where the group borders should lie.

If you are in any of the above postcodes you are urged to participate in this survey and let your wishes be known.

How to participate in this survey

This survey closes on the 21st September. The survey may be completed on line at the Lochac seneschal's web site http://www.sca.org.au/seneschal/, via e-mail to seneschal@sca.org.au, or via post to:

When sending in e-mail or postal surveys, please include the following information:

- 1. Your name.
- 2. Your SCA name.
- 3. Your membership number (if you are a member).
- 4. The postcode of the suburb in which you live.
- 5. The group that you would prefer to belong to.

If you fill in this survey on line, you will note that the name and SCA name fields are optional. Please provide either one of your name or SCA name, so that we know who you are. Anonymous survey responses may not be counted.

The options that you have for groups are:

- 1. Barony of Stormhold (central region not already covered by a Canton)
- 2. Canton of Newbridge (a proposed canton covering what was called central Stormhold)
- 3. Canton of Dubh Thrain (established proposed canton in northern suburbs)
- 4. Canton of Krae Glas (established canton in south-eastern suburbs, subject to a poll regarding changing to shire status after the postcode survey is concluded)
- 5. Shire of Arrowreach (established shire in eastern suburbs)

Other Polls

Note that two further polls need to be held after this survey:

- 1. A poll to determine whether Krae Glas should become a shire or remain a canton.
- 2. A poll to determine whether a canton in central Stormhold is wanted or not.

The poll to determine whether Krae Glas is to become a shire will only be finalised after this survey, as the results of this survey may change the final borders of Krae Glas and therefore affect the eligibility and effect of the Krae Glas poll.

Similarly, the poll to determine the viability of the canton of Newbridge will be held after this survey, once the proposed borders are established.
