# 3<sup>rd</sup> Krae Glas Baronial Investiture Steward's Report.

Event date: Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> of September 2020.

Event Steward: Sorcha ignen ui Chainnigh (Bronwyn Schoer)

Online Format: Zoom.

Booking numbers: 182.

The event was held in two parts, with an online royal court held through Zoom and broadcast live over a private youtube stream set up by Baroness Miriam from 4pm. The format then moved to a mass zoom format hosted by Baron Sir Gilbert Purchase from 6pm. This began with an opening court by the new Baron and Baroness, Jon dai of the Lane and Margey of Glenmore. The populace then moved to individual break-out rooms, co-ordinated by Mistress Nicolette, with various musical and bardic performers through out the evening. A feast cookbook was prepared and sent out before hand by Baron Alaine for the populace to select dishes for the virtual feast, along with a memorabilia colouring book put together by Alaine and Obbi il Lugi.

The event then ended with closing court at 10pm.

As this was an online event there is no income to report. Expenditure of \$79.10 for postage of Event tokens and baronial gifts.

Good general feedback from the populace. Some comments about the break out rooms where people would like to have been able to move out of certain rooms if possible. Also this format meant that the person assigning the rooms had to remain in the main "foyer" through out the night. Recommend that next time more than one person takes the roll of room co-ordinator and a roster is used to rotate them through the night.

Royal & Divest/Invest Court report, by Miriam bat Shimeon I offered to help with the live Court around a month ago. Once the team were put all together I advised that I still had access to the Lochac YouTube account, which was the preferred method for Court during the Symposium in July. This is mainly due to YouTube being freely accessible without the need for a Google account, or a Facebook account (if it had been fed to Facebook). I set up an event in YouTube, initially "unlisted" so that only those people with the link could see the event in YouTube. It was to go live at 4pm on Sept 12th. From there is used my Zoom account to link it to a Zoom meeting, set to start at 3:30pm (to get everyone set up). It was set to public a week before the event. My Zoom account is a Pro account, which could take up to 100 people. This allowed for a group to be in the Court as requested by Their Majesties, plus the outgoing and incoming B&B. Along with myself, this was 40 invites sent out to people to attend. However, these people did not attend Caristiona nic Beathain, Beatrice Maria Malatesta, Madilayn le Mercer, Amanda Constantiae, Amber, Dallan, Liadan, Vienna Maria Della Rosa, Master Baron Dimitrii Borodinskii, Medb ingen ind lasachta, and Ida Noe. I had been provided email addresses from some people but had taken the bulk of the contact information from the booking sheet. I had not heard from anyone that didn't attend, so I must assume that the email I sent out was perhaps picked up by their email spam filter, due to the amount of links within the email. There were some late people, such as Halla & Thomasina. If you watch the whole court they do appear onscreen for a short while but then I would turn off their video. This is something for future "producers" to be aware of. I had set up an active document in Google Docs, which Their Majesties, myself and both Court Heralds had access to. This greatly aided everyone knowing what was happening at which point. The stream went live just after 4pm, and can be seen here- <https://youtu.be/TzHqtOkjw3U> and as of 20 hours later has had 231 views! It ran for 47 minutes all together. I will leave the award report to the Court Herald to report. A recommendation for possible future online Courts When sending out the information on courts/classes etc to perhaps compile the information within a pdf document. This means that spam filters are unlikely to catch them, but links are active within the document. As for dealing with latecomers, possibly lock the meeting once the livestream has started?
